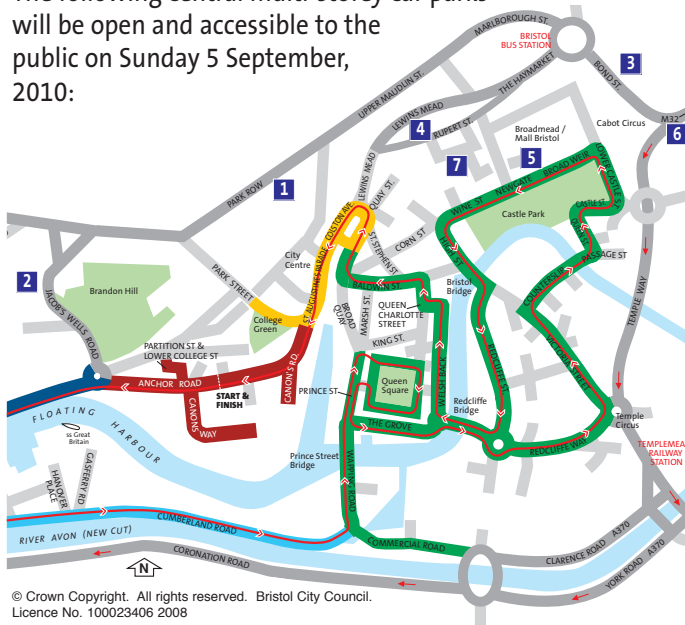

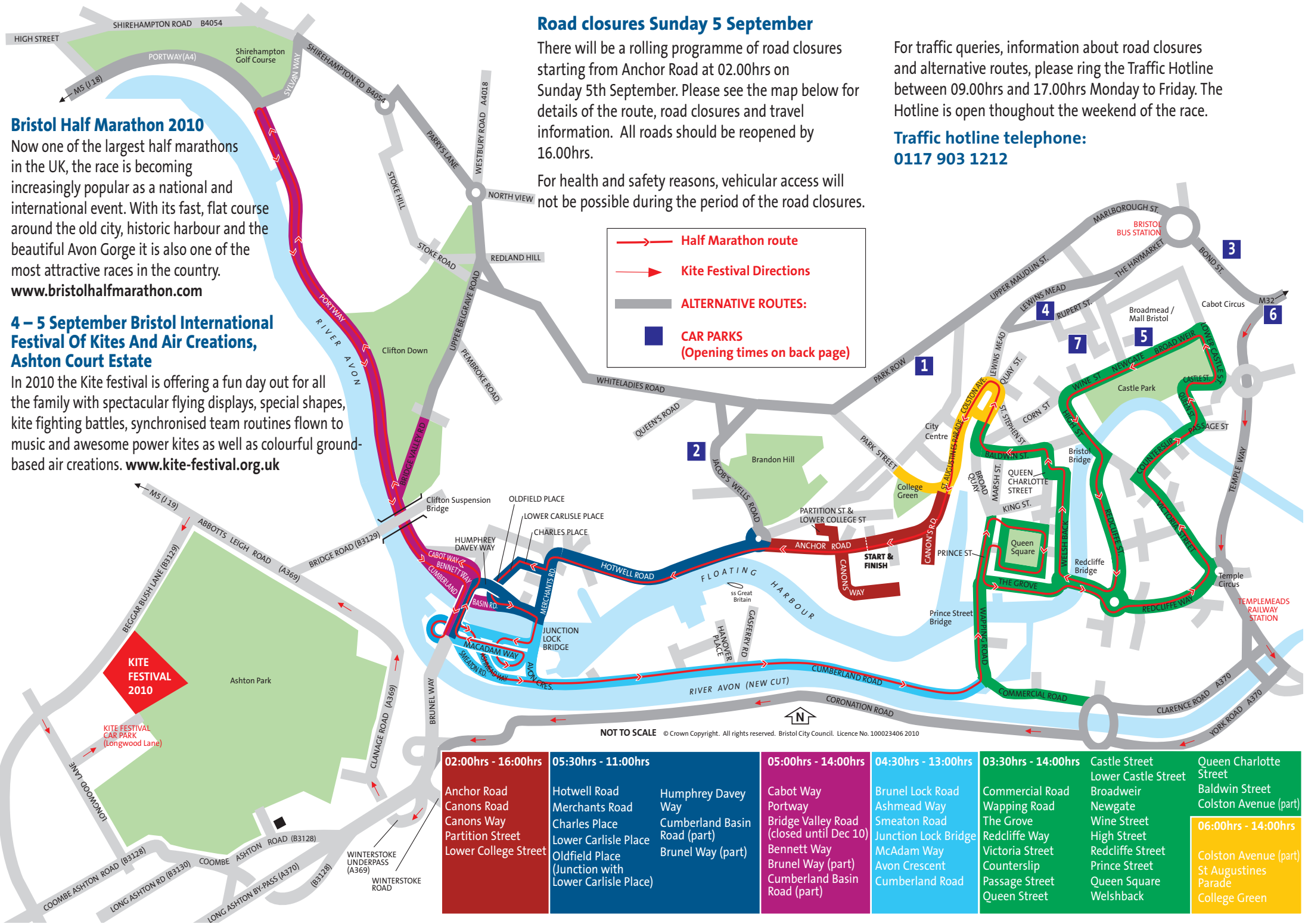
### Road closures Sunday 5 September
